DO BRING:

- Several pairs of trainers one for keeping dry and one or two old pairs for activities
- Waterproof coat
- <u>Lots</u> of pairs socks, including long & thick socks (not trainer socks)
- Lots of old clothes: Several pairs of jeans, tracksuit bottoms, trousers or leggings.
 Jumpers, sweatshirts & t-shirts which cover the shoulders
- Trainers and an old pair of trainers
- Underwear at least two pairs per day

- Pyjamas thick onesie
- Bedding sleeping bag & pillow & blanket
- Bin bags for dirty clothes & wet wellies
- Torch & batteries
