DO NOT BRING:

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DO BRING:

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| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pairs of trainers – one for keeping dry and at least one or two old pairs for activities Waterproof coat & Wellies Lots of pairs socks, including long & thick socks (not trainer socks) Lots of old clothes: Several pairs of jeans, tracksuit bottoms, trousers or leggings. Jumpers, sweatshirts & t-shirts which cover the shoulders Underwear – at least two pairs per day | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pyjamas Bedding – sleeping bag & pillow Bin bags for dirty clothes & wet wellies Torch & batteries Towels & toiletries Named purse with up to £5 spending money (in change) Swimwear Sun cream Sun hat / cap Water bottle |
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Please make sure that your child brings lots of OLD clothes as quite a few of the activities will result in your child getting wet & dirty and they may therefore need to change into fresh clothes in between activities.

Please ensure that all items of clothing are labelled!

Suitcases

Bring small suitcases or soft holdalls.

Cameras

We will be keeping you up to date with the activities via Twitter. However, if your child would like to take their own photos, they must do so with a disposable camera.

Snacks & Sweets

The food on Acorn Venture is fantastic. There is no need to bring extra sweets and snacks. If you do wish to send sweets with your child, this should be limited to one bag.

Medicine

There will be a dedicated member of staff in charge of looking after & distributing any medication that your child requires whilst we are away. The medicine **must** be clearly labelled with your child's name & a completed 'Request to Administer Medication' form. If your child requires an inhaler or Epi-pen, they **must** bring at least two with them. If they require Antihistamines for Allergies, they **must** bring enough for one per day.
